- Dr. Hellmut Schütte is a respected authority on international business and international marketing and management. He has a very strong understanding of Asia, first based in the region in 1972
- He is Distinguished Professor of Management, European Chair for Global Governance and Sino-European Relations at the China Europe International Business School (CEIBS) in Shanghai and is also Emeritus Professor of International Management at INSEAD in Singapore.
- Based in Singapore and Shanghai, he has lived in nine different countries, teaching in over forty of them
- His extensive research and teaching experience at INSEAD Business Schools has been primarily concerned with markets and consumers in Asia and more recently with the emergence of China and India. With greater regionalisation of corporate strategies, he has become sought-after as an advisor and commentator on Asia and the kinds of organisational structures multinational firms have embraced to take advantages of the opportunities of Asia markets
- He is a well-known speaker at conferences and business event, and actively involved in executive programmes, board and advisory roles and also consults for Asian and western organisations
